

Most healthcare facilities departments find themselves in one of these three categories when it comes to computerized maintenance management systems:

3. They do not own a CMMS and are struggling with a paper or “homemade” system.

2. If you are not confident that your present equipment inventory, preventative maintenance procedures and schedules are suitable to meet all regulatory standards, are cost effective, and it is in an electronic format; EQ2 will convert that data into a new HEMS Enterprise program and turn it over to the Implementation Services staff. The Implementation staff will edit your equipment inventory and provide any missing information on equipment or areas and schedule it to meet all regulatory requirements using their standard maintenance procedures.
3. If you are using a hard copy system or you have no faith in the information included in your present equipment inventory, EQ2’s Implementation staff will physically survey your equipment and enter it into your inventory to be scheduled using their standard preventative maintenance procedures. All pertinent information on the equipment; model number, equipment type, serial number, etc., will be included in the survey. All equipment will be given a proper control number, device inclusion designation and the risk factor for the equipment established.

In all three of the examples provided in this brochure, the following will be installed or will be available:

1. A double set of 3" x 1" polyester, thermal printed barcode labels, suitable for use in any area of a hospital, can be provided to be installed on all equipment and other inventory items either by the facility or EQ2, LLC, to accommodate the use of EQ2's mobile devices.
2. The existing system in scenarios #1 and #2 will be preserved for historical and regulatory purposes.
3. The inventory in all systems will be matched to EQ2's standard information lists providing all the information necessary for manufacturer, model number, serial number, system, maintenance class, device inclusion, location, risk assessment, etc.
4. A Smoke / Fire Compartment inspection program, a Utility Management program, an Environmental Zone inspection program, and EOC Rounds Inspection program are also available through EQ2's Implementation Services to meet all your regulatory needs.
